- Activities involving the generation of animal by-products on site only, which are carried out on farm or other
  premises where animals are kept, bred or taken care of do not need to notify with a view to registration
- Establishments or plants requiring approval under Article 24 of Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 or any activity
  associated with that establishment e.g. transport of ABPs. Such operations including rendering, incineration,
  combustion, pet food plants, manufacturers of organic fertilisers and soil improvers, compost and biogas
  plants, plants handling and storing animal by-products or products derived from animal by-products require
  approval. Application forms are available on the AHVLA website.
